Evaluation: Part I

In your summer reading, you learned what education meant to Malala, to her family, and to the Muslim society in which she lived.

Write a short speech recapping what you learned. EACH body section should be written as a well-developed paragraph, and include three supports from the text as examples of what you are saying.

Section 1: What did education mean to Malala?

Section 2: What did education mean to her family (brothers, mother, father, grandparents)?

Section 3: What did the education of Malala (or any other girl) mean to her Muslim society?

1. **To receive an A** on this part of the assignment,
 - you must have an introduction, 3 separate body paragraphs, and a conclusion.
 - EACH body paragraph must contain a topic sentence in which you directly answer the question asked.
 - EACH of your body paragraphs must include 3 examples, directly from the text, to support your answer.
 - Your grammar and spelling must be proficient
2. **To receive a B** on this part of the assignment,
 - you must have an introduction, 3 separate body paragraphs, and a conclusion.
 - EACH body paragraph must contain a topic sentence in which you directly answer the question asked.
 - EACH of your body paragraphs must include 2 examples, directly from the text, to support your answer.
 - Your grammar and spelling must be proficient
3. **To receive a C** on this part of the assignment,
 - you must have an introduction, 3 separate body paragraphs, and a conclusion.
 - EACH body paragraph must contain a topic sentence in which you directly answer the question asked.
 - EACH of your body paragraphs must include an example, directly from the text, to support your answer.
 - Your grammar and spelling must be proficient
4. **To receive a D** on this part of the assignment,
 - means you did not meet the requirements, but evidence of effort was present.
5. **To receive an F** on this part of the assignment,
 - means you did not meet the requirements, and there was no evidence of effort present.

Evaluation Part 2

Using the information that you learned from Malala and her experience, create a display on a large (regular size) tri-fold board.

In the middle section, answer the question: What does education means to YOU?

In the section to the left of the middle, answer the question: What does your education mean to your family (your siblings, parents, grandparents- you may quote them)

In the section to the right of the middle, answer the question: What does the education of girls mean to our city, state and country?

Use art work, clip art, poetry, quotes or any other creative medium you can put on the tri-fold to answer the questions. This project may be done **with** other family members.

1. **To receive an A** on this part of the assignment,
 - you must have at least 5 entries on each section of the tri-fold
 - the examples must fit the question being asked
 - your answers need to be creative
 - overall appearance must be neat
2. **To receive a B** on this part of the assignment,
 - you must have at least 4 entries on each section of the tri-fold
 - the examples must fit the question being asked
 - your answers need to be somewhat creative
 - overall appearance must be neat
3. **To receive a C** on this part of the assignment,
 - you must have at least 3 entries on each section of the tri-fold
 - the examples must fit the question being asked
 - your answers need to be somewhat creative
 - overall appearance is somewhat neat
4. **To receive a D** on this part of the assignment,
 - you had less than 3 entries on each section of the tri-fold
 - some examples did not fit the question being asked
 - your answers lacked creativity
 - overall appearance was messy
5. **To receive an F** on this part of the assignment,
 - you had less than 3 entries on each section of the tri-fold
 - most examples did not fit the question being asked
 - your answers lacked creativity
 - overall appearance was messy
